PANDEMIC PROTOCOLS AS OF JULY 2021

The Congregation Council has been reviewing and discussing Pandemic Protocols for over a year now, and will continue to do so.

Due to the changes with the Rock County Health Department's re-opening plan regarding Covid-19, the Congregation Council established the following protocol changes for our Sunday Services:

- * No masks are required for all vaccinated people.
- * For those not vaccinated, we recommend individuals should continue to wear masks.
- * We will continue to keep our safe seating arrangement throughout the pews.
- * We will designate the back 2 rows of seating (4 family groups) for individuals/families who want/need to wear masks, but also want to feel safe with those around them wearing masks also. These seats will have a designation on them for this purpose.
- * There will be no singing yet in church, except after service.

 As always, Council will review all protocols again at the next Council meeting. Please be patient. Nothing is permanent, and things will continue to change, hopefully moving us more toward "normal."
