and Session 4: Glory to God in the Highest – February 12, 2023.

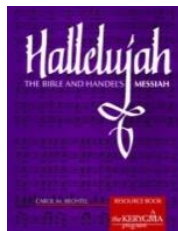
On February 19th, we will offer a CPR and AED training class in Friendship Hall.
