

SENIOR FARMERS' MARKET VOUCHERS

Rock County ADRC is making vouchers available to Seniors in Rock County. The vouchers are worth \$35 per person and may be used to purchase fresh produce from local farmers. <u>Who is eligible?</u>

Rock County Residents age 60 or older (Native Americans age 55 or older); monthly household income which does not exceed \$2249 for a one-person household, or \$3041 for a two-person household; and each eligible individual may receive vouchers only once in 2023.

<u>The voucher distribution for Janesville will take place on Tuesday, June 20th at the</u> <u>Rock County Resource Center at 1717 Center Ave., Janesville from 2-3:30 pm.</u> There are a limited number of vouchers available: distributions are on a first come-first served basis.
