

#### AGRACE OFFERS VIRTUAL GRIEF SUPPORT IN FEBRUARY

Local adults and children living in southern Wisconsin who are grieving can find hope and healing with the help of grief support specialists at Agrace. This February, Agrace hosts "Bridges," a virtual support group for adults who are grieving the death of a person. This group provides emotional and peer support in a professionally led group setting and requires advance registration. Bridges meets Tuesday, February 14, from 9:30 a.m. to 11 a.m., via Zoom. There is no fee for Agrace grief support if a participant's family member was served by Agrace



Hospice Care or another hospice in the past 12 months. Modest fees may apply for others, and fees can be lowered or waived, if needed. One-on-one grief support is also available by phone or video chat. This support is open to *anyone*, even if the person who died did not have hospice care.
